The EU funds available for Priority Projects are of 5,5 billion €. Only for the project of the Base Tunnel of Turin-Lyon France and Italy may require the EU co-financing between 4,0 and 5,2 billion € (i.e. 40% of the project cost which is not yet known, but estimated between 10 and 13 billion). The EU contribution requested by France and Italy would therefore equal between 73% and 95% of European funds available for dozens of projects in 13 States. ## 2.4. Redeployment of commitment appropriations for provisioning the guarantee fund in 2015

An amount of EUR 1 350 million in commitment appropriations is proposed to be redeployed to the new budget article (01 04 05) to provision the EFSI guarantee fund for the year 2015.

The Commission proposes to reduce the CEF commitment appropriations by EUR 790 million as shown in the table below. The proposed reductions take into account the expected delivery of the programme as well as the respective sector-specific multi-annual work programmes so that the activities already planned for 2015 are not undermined.
